

Major Canadian Jewish Literary Prize Re-launched!

Toronto. 23rd February, 2016. The **Koffler Centre of the Arts** is proud to announce the **Vine Awards for Canadian Jewish Literature**. This prestigious prize will replace the Helen and Stan Vine Canadian Jewish Book Awards that the Centre administrated for over twenty years, with a brief hiatus last year for re-framing.

The newly branded prize will honour the best Jewish Canadian writing in four categories; fiction, non-fiction, history and young adult/children's literature; each with a prize of \$10,000. An additional \$10,000 prize for poetry will also be awarded every three years. Submissions published in 2014 and 2015 will be accepted this year, and both digital and print publications will be considered by the Jury. The submission deadline is June 3rd, 2016. The short-list will be announced in August 2016, and the winners in the four/five categories will be announced in Fall 2016. www.kofflerarts.org/vineawards
